ELIGIBILITY: Open to any amateur junior girl golfer who has been a legal resident of South Carolina six (6) months prior to the beginning of the tournament; have not reached their 19th birthday by June 16, 2010 and have not entered college.

ENTRIES: **Entries open on April 19, 2010.** All entries must be filed on attached form and received by **5:00 p.m. on May 31, 2010.** The field will be limited to 96 players. Entry fee is \$75.00. You will be notified of your acceptance by June 1, 2009. *Refunds are not made after entries close.*

FORMAT: USGA Rules apply. Local Rules will be distributed at the tournament site. The Championship is contested at 54 holes stroke play. Players are flighted according to age. Age groups will be as follows:

8-9	Five Holes
10-11-12	Nine Holes
13-14-15	Eighteen Holes
16-17-18	Eighteen Holes

Players must report to the starter's table five (5) minutes prior to the starting time. Contestants must walk during the Championship. Players may carry their bag or use a pull cart. ***Contestants are required to participate in all activities.***

RESTRICTIONS: No cut-off shorts or denim, no shorts shorter than four inches above the knee, no tank tops or t-shirts, all shirts must have either a collar or sleeves. Metal golf shoe spikes are prohibited.
