



One-Day Tournaments



Regular members have the opportunity to participate in approximately 26 one-day events held throughout the year. These one-day tournaments are scheduled monthly in different areas of the state, affording members the chance to play at some of the finest golf courses in South Carolina and to meet women from all over the state.

The WSCGA State Representative at your club will post the one-day schedule for the tournaments to be held each month. One-Day tournaments are held February through December. Registration is done on an individual basis, on-line at www.wscga.org (also found on the www.wscga.org website).

General Information:

1. You **must enter one-day tournaments from the club which you receive your USGA handicap-index**. Partners in one-day Best-Ball tournaments do not have to belong to the same club.
2. You do not need to be a resident of South Carolina to participate.
3. You must have a WSCGA handicap from a South Carolina club that utilizes the Handicap System of the Carolinas (GHIN).
4. **The Handicap-Index Limit is 40.4. If you're index is higher you are still eligible to play, however, you will only receive 40.4.** You will receive 95% of the course handicap for Stroke Play one-day tournaments; 85% of the course handicap for Best Ball one-day tournaments; Other One-day formats Handicap allowance will be posted on the events page.
5. Online registration is available for all events with entries opening six weeks prior to the event at 9:00am.
6. On-line registration will not be accepted prior to "opening date. Final entry deadline is two weeks prior to the event at 5:00 p.m.
7. All entries shall be accepted on a first come, first served basis except a WSCGA Board Member and a WSCGA JGF Board Member will have priority entry into all events. The field is limited to 100 total entries. If the field is full, the 100-field limit **should not** include players from the Host Club.
8. Entry fee includes: cart, golf, lunch and prizes. A practice round is not included for One-Day tournaments. A reduced greens fee for a practice round should not be requested or expected.
9. Entries accepted or on waitlist will be notified by email.
10. Cart Fee is included in Entry fee and paid at time of registration. All players in one-day tournaments are required to use a golf cart. Cart fees will vary from club to club; therefore, entry fees will vary. The WSCGA has requested that the host clubs regular cart fee be extended, but this is not guaranteed.
11. If a player needs to cancel after the deadline, her entry may be transferred to another WSCGA member. The WSCGA must be notified in advance. Cancellations 8-14 days prior to event will result in a \$6 cancellation fee; 0-7 days prior to event will be a \$26 cancellation fee.

Note: Remember, entries will be accepted on first come, first served basis. Those individuals not accepted into a particular one-day may check the other one-day sites for availability.
